

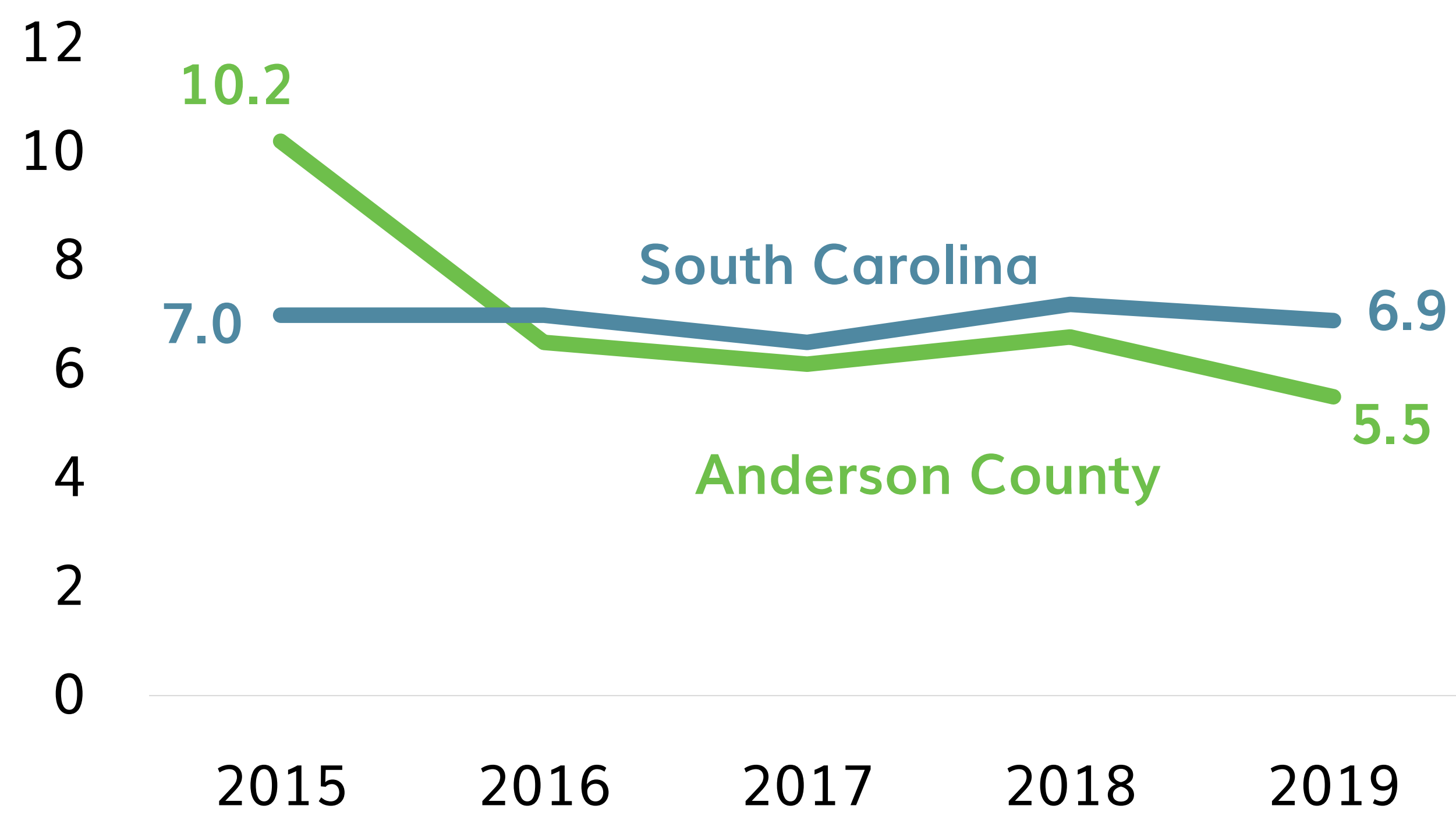

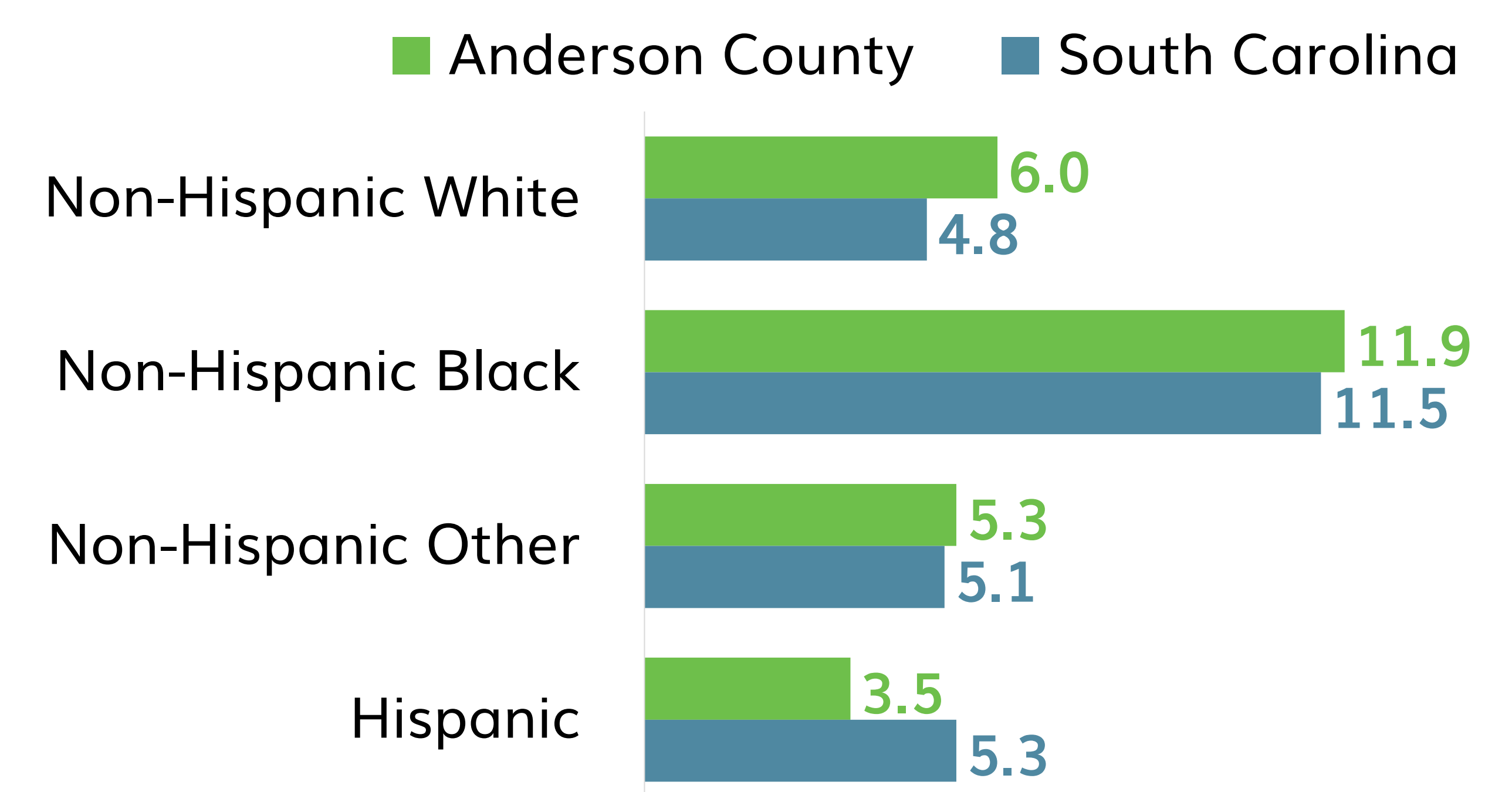
Rate per 1,000 live births

Top Leading Causes of Infant Death

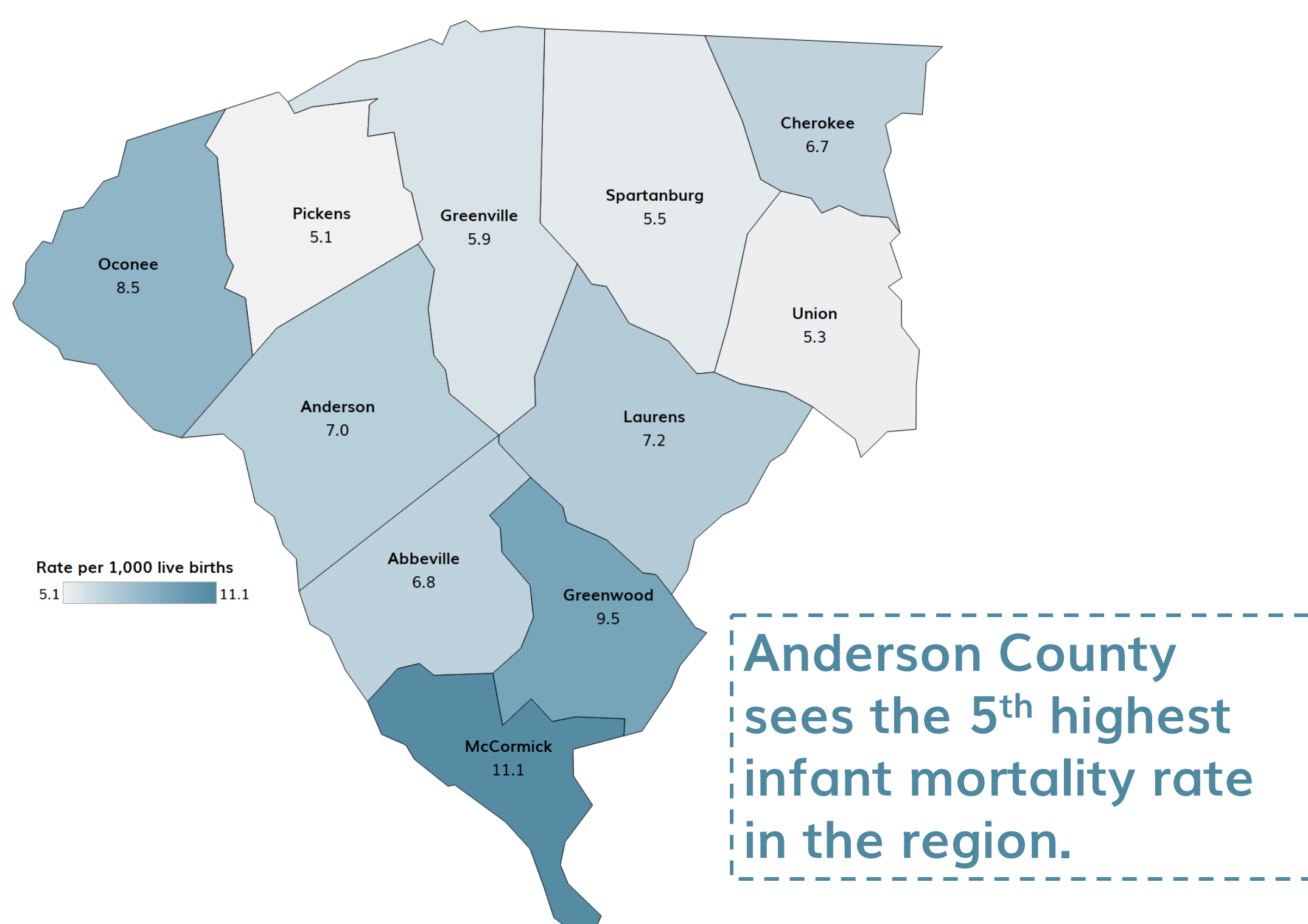

Congenital Malformations	1	2 (tied)	2	6
Preterm Birth/Low Birthweight	2	3 (tied)	3	2
Accidents or Unintentional Injuries	3	1	1	1
Maternal Complications of Pregnancy	4	-	-	10
Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS)	5	-	9	-

Accidents or unintentional injuries, newborn affected by maternal complications of the placenta, and intrauterine hypoxia and birth asphyxia are tied as the third leading cause of death among non-Hispanic Black infants.

5-Year Infant Mortality, by County

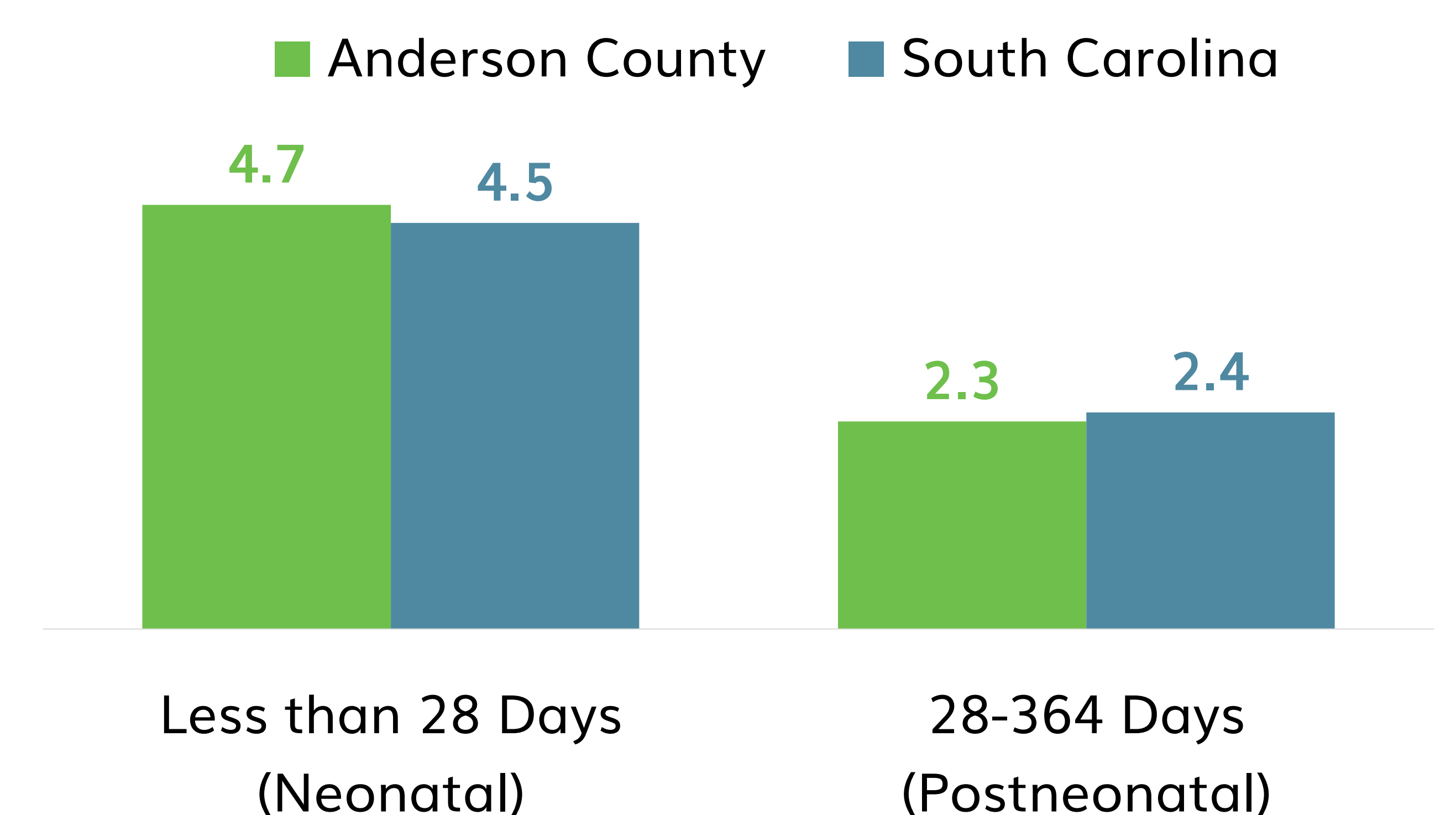
Rate per 1,000 live births
